



Associate of Arts – Liberal Arts Transfer

The Liberal Arts Transfer Program assists students in the pursuit of knowledge and information, challenges them to act responsively on that knowledge and information, and then offers them opportunities to put that knowledge and information into action.

Graduates of the program will:

1. Meet the general education requirements of Washington State and be prepared to transfer to a four-year institution as a junior.
2. Demonstrate specific knowledge within their discipline of study through analysis, evaluation and communication of information from within the discipline.
3. Demonstrate methods for critically acquiring and evaluating information, drawing conclusions between and among various disciplines, and defending those conclusions rationally in effective oral and written communications.
4. Apply decision-making processes by synthesizing ideas drawn from broad areas of knowledge.
5. Demonstrate an understanding of the world beyond their immediate experience.
