NOTE: Program eligibility requirements include income below 200% of the Metro LLSIL. (family of 1 under \$27,131, family of 2 under \$44,474, family of 3 under \$61,043 and family 4 under \$75,360). If you are collecting unemployment you may be eligible regardless of income. If you are an Ohio resident or a resident of another state but lost your job from an Ohio company you may be eligible.
