**Franklin University Transfer Notes:**

- *Laboratory component needed for at least 1 science course.*
- *For the Social Sciences requirement, students must take courses in at least 2 separate disciplines.*
- *Both General Education and University Electives must be non-developmental.*
- *Students may select up to 8 credit hours of select graduate coursework for elective credit.*
  - *Transfer credit hour minimums for a 4-hour Franklin course is 2.67 semester hours. The difference in transferred credit and Franklin course credit must be made up in the General Education Elective and/or University Elective sections.*
