- To assist in advising students from Washington State Community College who wish to pursue a bachelor's degree at WVU Parkersburg.

For students to be accepted into the BAEE program upon transfer, WSCC students must also meet the following conditions:

- 3.0 gpa
- No grade below a C
- 75 hours of service learning (approved by program manager in conjunction with WVU Parkersburg)
- ACT composite score of 26 **OR** Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators scores of Reading 156, Writing 162, Math 150
- Completed transfer application by March 1st or October 1st prior to the semester of their transfer

WVU Parkersburg will:

- Work with WSCC to advise students
- Students will be required to meet the course catalog requirements based on the year of start at WVU Parkersburg
- Accept WSCC's LITR 2600 Children's Literature as meeting the requirements for WVU-Parkersburg's English 403 Children's Literature
