SAFETY PROTOCOLS



REQUIRED FACE COVERINGS All employees, students and visitors to campus will be required to wear face coverings.



DAILY HEALTH ASSESSMENTS All employees and students will be required to take their temperature each day before coming to campus.



CLEANING AND SANITIZING Campus facilities and maintenance will continue increased cleaning and sanitizing all workplaces and classrooms throughout workday, between courses and at the close of business.



SOCIAL DISTANCING Capacity will be limited to ensure compliance with social distancing guidelines. On-campus class sizes will be reduced.

Access points into the college will be limited to monitor compliance with face coverage and health assessments.

STUDENT REOPENING PLAN

PHASE 1

- ➡ Campus will remain closed through May.
- ➡ Remote coursework will continue through the end of Spring Semester (May 15).
- ➡ Students who have lab courses that cannot be completed remotely will receive a Spring semester grade of Incomplete.
- ➡ Students will be contacted in May about completing their coursework during Phase 2 of the reopening.

PHASE 2

- ➡ Campus will reopen for limited face-to-face courses at the start of Summer semester, June 1.
- ➡ The majority of summer courses will be delivered remotely.
- ➡ Students with a Spring semester grade of Incomplete and those registered for certain summer classes, such as labs, will report to campus following directions provided by their course instructors.
- ➡ Any Spring semester Incomplete grades will be replaced with a letter grade once missing coursework is completed. The deadline for Spring semester grade changes is July 10.



VISITORS TO CAMPUS

The WSCC campus will remain closed to visitors during the month of May. Beginning June 1, visitors will be permitted on campus by appointment only. All visitors to campus will be required to follow the safety protocols listed above.
