Washington State Community College has had no barriers to or incidents of disruption of free expression on our campus, including attempts to block or prohibit speakers and any investigation of students or student groups on the basis of expression during the inception of Senate Bill 40.

Washington State Community College also can report that students have the freedom to report any issues such as this matter to our Maxient Report System. To date there have been no complaints filed regarding freedom of expression. The Washington State Community College Leadership Cabinet also reported no complaints or questions regarding freedom of speech have been brought to their attention. We also asked the question on our campus kiosk feedback system regarding our students' belief if we support freedom of expression. The average response was 4.87 on a 5-point scale.

Washington State Community College will continue to do everything it can to provide it's student, staff and faculty a warm safe and welcoming environment.
